During 2021/22, Centrepont supported almost **13,000** young people, directly and through our partners across the UK.



93 per cent of the young people who left Centrepont in 2021/22 **moved on positively** into accommodation, jobs and/or training.



65 per cent of young people who left Centrepont in 2021/22 were in **education, employment or training** meaning they can take the next step into independence.

In 2021/22 Centrepont supported **1,068** young people with supported housing, **143** with move-on accommodation and **571** through floating support.



The Centrepont Helpline supported **6,877** young people during 2021/22 with advice, emotional support and access to supported housing.



55 per cent of Centrepont residents who took Centrepont Works training courses in 2021/22 **finished with a qualification** giving them a stronger foundation for building a successful career.



63 per cent of young people receiving support from Centrepont's Psychotherapy and Mental Health team **reduce the severity of their symptoms**. We want to make this number 100% but need more financial resources to implement our ambitious plans.



We estimate almost **122,000** young people asked for help from their council in 2020/21 because they were homeless or at risk of homelessness.
